Many people will attend the auction preview on Friday afternoon to get a last look at some pieces of Front Range history. The auction preview allows potential buyers plenty of time to inspect the items for sale before the actual live auction on Saturday morning. The live auction kicks off at 10:10 AM on Saturday April 5, 2008. Even if you cannot attend the auction in person, you can still bid.
